### Several Special Reminders

From GMC Chair Kathy Dillon-Durica:

Weather permitting, tomorrow beginning at 9:00 a.m. the Greenbelt Management Committee needs volunteers to help pile slash located on Tract F, Filing 13 at the intersection of Osage Trail and Flathead Drive. Bring rakes, tarps, gloves and lots of energy. Hopefully we will be able to finish our part in a few hours. Each volunteer hour will credit us with \$20 towards our matching grant with the Colorado State Forest Service, so it will be saving Crystal Lakes money for other projects in our greenbelts. Remember, a liability waiver is required for anyone who works in our greenbelts. However, if the weather is wet and/or snowy tomorrow, we will have to reschedule the slash pick-up party. If the forecast is incorrect, Kathy will be there tomorrow at 9 a.m.; if the weather is bad Saturday and better on Sunday, she will try then.

Summit Forestry owner Tony Mahon has donated 3½ hours of chipping to help with the slash and small logs piled at the top of the hill; thanks Tony.

From the Fishing Board and F.B. President Lou Phillippe:

Beaver Lake is planned for dredging for silt removal and to improve water flow on Saturday, October 22. From now until that date, property owners (with current fishing badges) and ACCOMPANIED guests with valid guest fishing permits may catch and keep as many fish as they wish from Beaver Lake. This is for Beaver Lake ONLY, and DOES NOT apply to unaccompanied guests, renters, etc. It is a benefit for property owners. Good luck and good fishing!"

From dredging project lead Bryon Fessler:

Mobile Way and Snoopy Pond & access road will be closed October 17, 2011, until the Catawba Pond dredging project is completed. Trucks will be hauling silt and dredged material from Catawba Pond to a drying area established below Panhandle Dam. The truck route will be from Mobile Way down Nowata Drive to Ottawa and Snoopy Pond access, returning via Ottawa Way North to Mobile Way. Please be aware of that truck traffic and avoid those roadways as much as possible. Plan your driving routes accordingly. Local traffic by property owners of lots on Mobile Way and Catawba Court will be allowed on the south end of Mobile Way to Catawba Court.
