Extremely cold temperatures this morning create hazardous conditions. Be aware that temperatures in Crystal Lakes range from -7 degrees to -27 degrees. The weather forecast predicts these frigid temperatures will remain today and tonight, with a quick warm-up tomorrow before another cold front and more snow arrive Thursday. Use extra caution if you must be outdoors at all. These low temperatures are extremely dangerous if appropriate precautions are not taken, and any wind will raise the risk exponentially.

Roads in Crystal Lakes on the regular plow route have been plowed, but remain icy and snow packed. If you need a road opened that is not on the regular route, call the office with your request, allowing 72 hours notice. We have between one and two feet of snow throughout the subdivision, with drifts and pockets much deeper. (We're getting ready for Santa's sleigh to arrive for the Christmas party potluck next Saturday. Don't miss the fun starting at 4:00 p.m.)
